Security Act of 2007 and by the available unobligated balances within federal funding categories.
Because funding obligations in North Carolina do exactly match those anticipated by SAFETEA-LU
and because FHWA has assured the State that it will not require projects to be de-obligated it is likely
that long range planning, Interstate Maintenance, Highway Safety, Congestion Mitigation and Air
Quality, and the STP-DA program for larger MPOs will be most seriously affected. These are
programs intended to meet important safety needs or to flexibly address more local needs within
urban or nonattainment areas.
