14 (b) ~~Transfer. General Fund Transfer.~~ – In each fiscal year year, the State Treasurer shall
15 transfer the amounts provided below from the taxes deposited in the Trust Fund to the General
16 Fund. The transfer of funds authorized by this section may be made by transferring one-fourth
17 of the amount at the end of each quarter in the fiscal year or by transferring the full amount
18 annually on July 1 of each fiscal year, subject to the availability of revenue.

19 (1) The sum of ~~seventy-one million dollars (\$71,000,000).~~ forty million dollars
20 (\$40,000,000).

22 (c) Mobility Fund Transfer. – In each fiscal year, the State Treasurer shall transfer
23 thirty-one million dollars (\$31,000,000) from the taxes deposited in the Trust Fund to the
24 Mobility Fund. The transfer of funds authorized by this section may be made by transferring
25 one-fourth of the amount at the end of each quarter in the fiscal year or by transferring the full
26 amount annually on July 1 of each fiscal year, subject to the availability of revenue.'

27 SECTION 28.7.(e) G.S. 105-187.9, as amended by this act, reads as rewritten:
28 '§ 105-187.9. Disposition of tax proceeds.

30 (b) General Fund Transfer. – In each fiscal year, the State Treasurer shall transfer the
31 amounts provided below from the taxes deposited in the Trust Fund to the General Fund. The
32 transfer of funds authorized by this section may be made by transferring one-fourth of the



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1 amount at the end of each quarter in the fiscal year or by transferring the full amount annually
2 on July 1 of each fiscal year, subject to the availability of revenue.

3 (1) The sum of ~~forty million dollars (\$40,000,000)~~; twenty-six million dollars
4 (\$26,000,000).

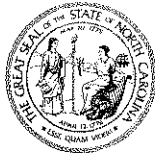

6 (c) Mobility Fund Transfer. – In each fiscal year, the State Treasurer shall transfer
7 ~~thirty-one million dollars (\$31,000,000)~~ forty-five million dollars (\$45,000,000) from the taxes
8 deposited in the Trust Fund to the Mobility Fund. The transfer of funds authorized by this
9 section may be made by transferring one-fourth of the amount at the end of each quarter in the
10 fiscal year or by transferring the full amount annually on July 1 of each fiscal year, subject to
11 the availability of revenue.'

12 **SECTION 28.7.(f)** Subsection (d) of this section becomes effective July 1, 2011.
13 Subsection (e) of this section becomes effective July 1, 2012."
