Dear Mr. President and Honorable Members of the NC Congressional Delegation:

As members of the North Carolina Metropolitan Mayors Coalition we have developed a great appreciation of the many similarities among our state's largest cities. We are the economic engines of our great state. Our residents depend on us for core services such as police and fire protection. Our local businesses depend on us for the infrastructure that allows for the movement of their goods and services. In turn, we rely on federal programs such as the Community Development Block Grant, Community Oriented Policing Programs, and transportation dollars to provide those needed services. We are greatly concerned that all of that is at risk as we listen to the discussion taking place in Washington around the debt ceiling crisis.

We cannot weather instability in the municipal bond market which will further slow infrastructure investments and job creation. We cannot stress enough the damage you will do to our cities and our State if you do not find common ground and resolve the debt ceiling issue.

We are asking you to focus again, above all else, on job creation. And we are asking you to address the debt ceiling now.
